Darren Heppel, a staff member at Steve's Leaves in Lewisville, TX, was chosen Hybridizer of the Year at the 2022 Southwest Region Get-Together in Fort Worth, TX. At the 2023 ABS/SWR Convention in Tyler, TX, he won the Dianna Wilkerson Award for Best Rhizomatous and Best Southwest Region Hybrid with B. 'The Iron Maiden.'
