The show will be held at the Holiday Inn Hotel & Suites Northwest, 1801 Development Blvd., which is off of I-35, on the north side of Waco. Exit Lake Shore (Loop 340) and take the east Service Road to Development Blvd. (it is behind Home Depot).
