The Austin Area Begonia Society met at 2 P.M. Sunday, April 27, 2025 in the Zilker Botanical Garden Center. Twenty members were present to work on terrariums — creating new worlds using supplies that they could choose since the large terrarium requires a greater selection and use of imagination. Doug Byrom opened the covered tables that held supplies for creating this special world that could keep begonias alive. Doug held a pad that would hold dampness and then charcoal and planting mixes to keep the tiny begonias alive.
